

# D2.3 SDGs Relevance Report

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#### Executive summary

This report is intended to assess and highlight the relevance of each of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals in and through the Cultural and Creative Industries and in particular to the following sub-sectors characterizing the activities carried out by the project's Partners, in view of taking action to align strategies and operations to the SDGs: "events and experiences design", "Heritage services", "Tourism and urban/rural reactivation", "Literature, publishing, libraries", "Museums, galleries".

In fact, businesses and other organizations in the CCIS, willing to engage for the advancement of the SDGs, need to identify and set priorities, examining on which SDGs, and corresponding targets, they can have the most impact, while at the same time improving their operations, pinpointing the needed resources to be allocated and defining appropriate timelines; in this perspective, a SDGs alignment actions can be seen as a set of principles that can be leveraged to evaluate and manage social, economic, and environmental risks while enhancing operations, profitability, brand recognition, reputation, and strategic positioning in current and future marketplaces.

From a practical stand point, the report will help the partners and other future users, in the shorter-term within this project's scope, to conceive and develop creative events inspired by the Sustainable Development Goals, through the proposed culture-based project's methodology, in the longer-term to design and implement long lasting strategic and operational alignment actions, being aware that plentiful tools have been developed and are available, to assist large companies in maximizing their contribution to the SDGs, and making an attempt to get inspiration from them and making it accessible also to those small and medium sized operators which, like the project's partners, make up the vast majority of organizations active in the CCls, which will be further substantiated in the design and release of the so-called "SDGs alignment handbook, to which the present report happens to be preliminary.

By the same token, if the "SDGs alignment handbook" will be conceived to provide both theoretical knowledge and operational practices with regard to possible concrete alignment actions to be undertaken, the present "SDGs Relevance Report" establishes itself as a compass, assessing the level (high, mild, scarce) of relevance of each Sustainable Development Goal to the five specific sub-sectors, mentioned above, and indicating the most effective directions of intervention, initiatives and options in terms of maximizing the positive difference or shrinking negative impacts the most, getting aware on where to direct attention and investments, helping to narrow beforehand the area of interventions and the required resources.

Keeping in mind the different national and local contexts in which the project's Partners operate, aligning to the SDGs can help achieve long-term business success while having at the same time a positive societal impact, through ethical and responsible business practices, encompassing also mainstreaming, promotion, and advocacy activities, depending on whether specific business activities can have a direct or indirect practical relevance to the different SDGs, along with corresponding targets and indicators. Finally, while preparing this report, we become more and more aware on the transformational potential for our organizations as well as for others active in the CCIs of embracing a strategic approach to the SDGs, thanks to the high-level mapping assessment of their relevance to our value chains, identifying those areas with high likelihood of positive impacts on the issues that the SDGs represent, both current impacts and the likelihood of future ones.
